Bountiful Irrigation Customer,

With the 60% reduction in the District's water contracts, the Board of Trustees passed a drought resolution on April 6, 2022, with the following regulations taking effect immediately:

- Outdoor watering is prohibited between the hours of 10:00 am and 6:00 pm.
- Rinsing or washing of sidewalks, driveways, patios, or other impervious surfaces is not permitted.
- All landscaping, turf, plantings, and gardens are limited to one watering portion per week:

One watering portion is equal to the following:

- 20 minutes (per zone) for pop-up style sprinkler heads or
 - 40 minutes (per zone) for rotary-style sprinkler heads.
 - 60 minutes (per zone) for drip systems or soaker systems

- Established trees and shrubs are allowed one 20 minute hand-watering portion per week. *The hose shall not be left unattended and shall not be connected to a sprinkler head.*
 - Watering of **any** newly installed landscaping shall comply with these same restrictions.
 - High-use public facilities will be irrigated to prevent permanent damage to turf or landscaping to provide outdoor facilities that the community can enjoy and to protect public investments.
 - Bountiful Ridge Golf Course may water tee boxes and greens to maintain acceptable playing conditions and to preserve public investment. "Spot-watering" is permitted in the fairway and rough areas to prevent permanent damage to landscaping or turf. The use of secondary water for such purposes shall not exceed 40% of the property's annual allotment.

Bountiful Irrigation employees are authorized to enforce the above-noted regulations as follows:

- First Offense - Written Warning.
- Second Offense - Water valve shut off and locked with a \$100 turn-on fee.
- Third Offense - Water valve shut off and locked with a \$250 turn-on fee.
- Fourth Offense - Water valve shut off and locked with a \$500 turn-on fee.
- Fifth Offense - Service terminated for the remainder of the season and a \$1000 turn-on fee for the next irrigation season.
- **Any** tampering with a locked water valve/box will result in the same penalties as a Fifth Offense.
- The property owner shall also be responsible for any possible disconnection and reconnection fees.

Where meters are installed, water use reaching 40% of the property's annual water allotment will have its meter locked for the remainder of the season.
